

## **UK Brachycephalic Working Group Strategy 2022-2025**

Brachycephalic Working Group (BWG) is composed of organisations representing the major dog welfare stakeholders in the UK.

**BWG** was established in 2016 to address health and welfare problems associated with selective breeding for brachycephaly (a flattened face) in dogs e.g. English Bulldog, French Bulldog Pug.



While some progress has been made, we recognise there is still a long way to go to safeguard the welfare of dogs from brachycephaly - both to reduce the negative impacts of brachycephaly on the current generation of dogs and to breed towards less extreme and healthier dogs for future generations.

## **BWG Strategy Development**

The new BWG strategy gives an updated direction and plan for 2022-2025.

- A questionnaire was distributed to members of BWG and external groups interested in the welfare of dogs with brachycephaly. e.g. dog breed clubs, dog registering bodies, veterinary and academic bodies, all-party parliamentary groups, charities, media representatives and others.
- The questionnaire asked how respondents felt about the BWG: what was being done well, what could be done better, what had been done badly or had failed to be addressed.
